## Job Description

## Second Vice President

- 1. The 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President shall exercise all the powers and discharge all the duties of the President and/or the 1<sup>st</sup> Vice President, in the absence and/or disability of both the President and 1<sup>st</sup> Vice President and perform such other duties as may be assigned to him/her by the Board of Trustees or the President.
- 2. He/she shall assist the President in the management of the association and keep himself/herself informed on all the functions of the office and policies of the association.
- 3. In the event of the resignation, death or removal of the 1<sup>st</sup> Vice President, the 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President shall fill the unexpired term of the 1<sup>st</sup> Vice President. In the event of the resignation, death or removal of the President and 1<sup>st</sup> Vice President, the 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President shall fill the unexpired term of the President
- 4. The 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President shall serve on the Budget and Finance Committee
- 5. He/she shall be available for the Annual Foot and Ankle Scientific Seminar to assist the facilitation of the meeting on site.
- 6. He/she shall serve as a member of the Executive Committee and attend scheduled meetings of the Executive Committee as well as the Board of Trustees.
- 7. Shall evaluate, approve or reject, within 7 days, all CME programming remitted to OHFAMA for podiatric credit in OH. Notification should be given to OHFAMA staff so that the remitting organization can be notified of status.
- 8. Participate in leadership orientation.
